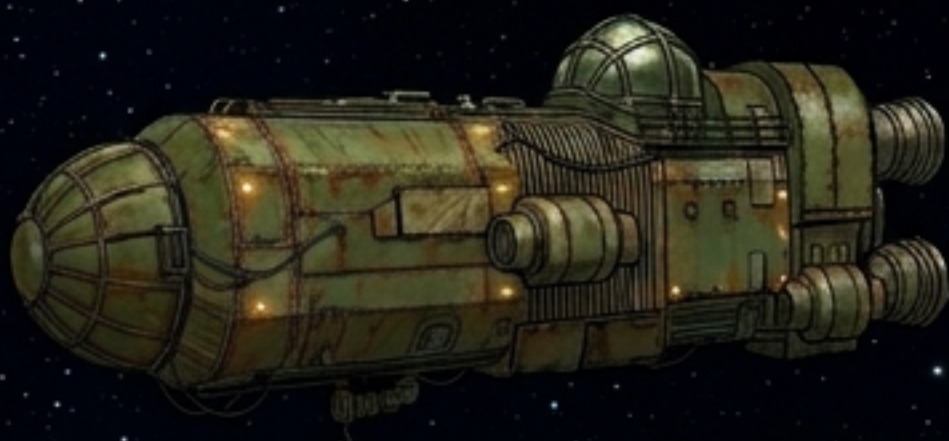

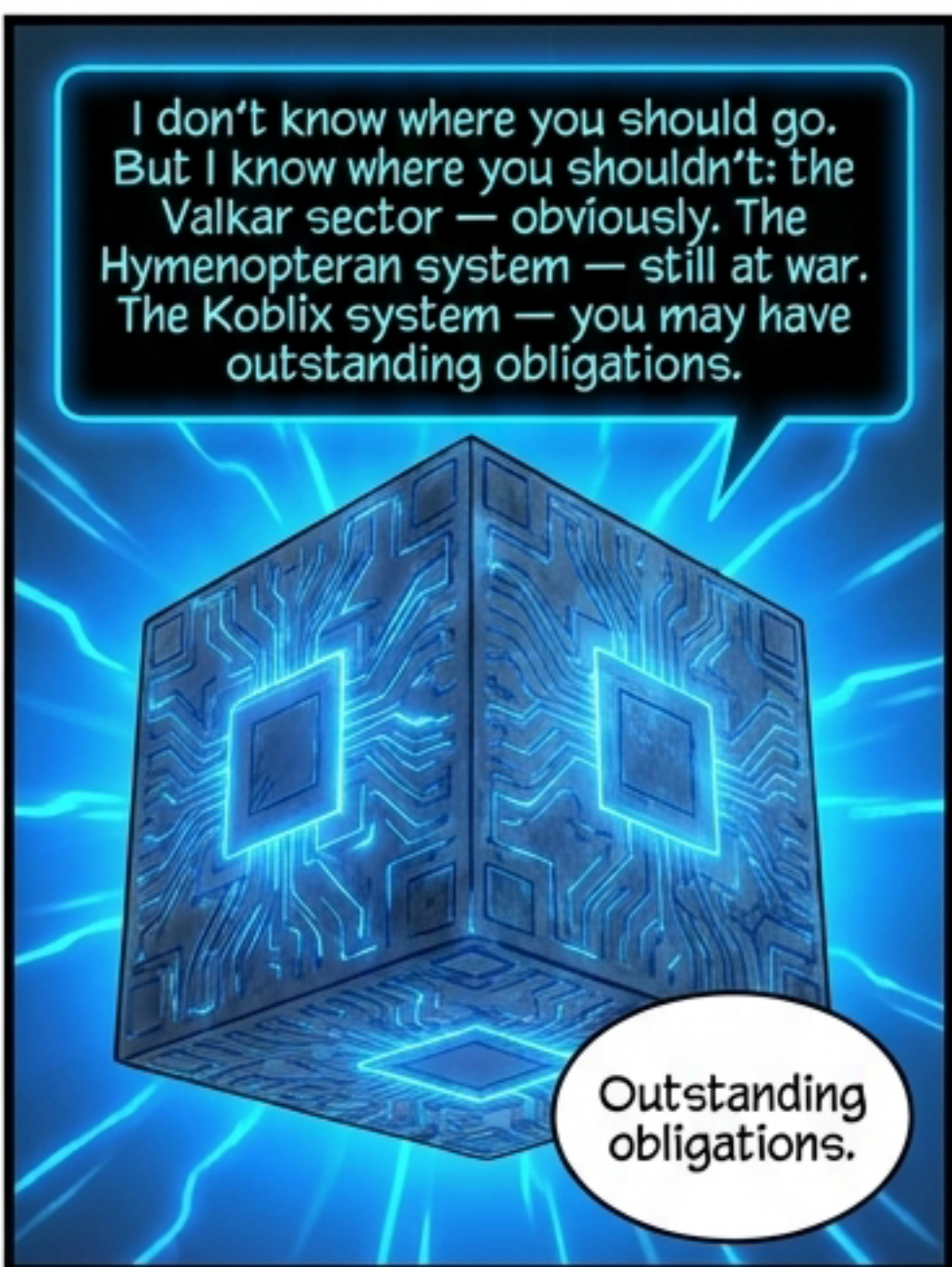




Where do you think we should go?

were still there.





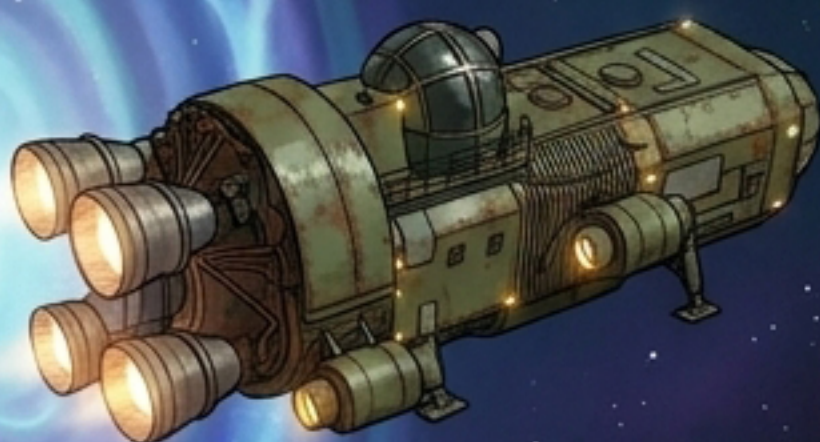
